

The main thrust of the school is to form, in the students, habits of diligence and piety, and instill in them a sense of perseverance, fortitude and hope.



English is mandatory:

Passing in English is mandatory. Students are encouraged to communicate in English while they are in school. At home too, parents must insist that they converse in English, so that they retain what they learn in school and become more and more proficient in the use of the language.

Great stress is laid on the teaching and drilling of the functional and communicative aspects of the language. Quizzes, elocutions, story telling, debates, spelling bee and other competitions are held to enable the students to learn proper articulation, pronunciation, grammar, diction and other nuances of the English language. The whole objective is to make the students, more outgoing and confident in expressing themselves, once they get into public life.

Discipline and Conduct:

The whole school atmosphere is geared to instil into the students a sense of good discipline, courteous behavior and gentlemanly conduct. Students learn to internalize disciplinary behavior, propriety in conduct and speech, and exude a distinct flavor that sets them apart from the ordinary rank and file.

Admissions:

Admissions to classes Nursery to X and higher will be made on the basis of an entrance test in Maths and English, to test the competence of the candidate for the class in which the admission is sought. The following documents will be needed.

- 1. 3 sets of passport size photographs, as recent as three months before the date of admission.
- 2. Birth certificate or Transfer certificate is compulsory
- 3. Birth certificate as issued by municipality or similarly competent authority, government hospitals, block, panchayats. Court affidavits and any other documents, besides those indicated above, will not be accepted.
- 4. Parents must abide by the rules and regulations of the school framed from time to time.

Uniform and Dress Code:

Linked closely with discipline and conduct comes uniform and dress code of the student, whether boy or girl. Students are expected to come neatly dressed and properly groomed.

Tight fitting dress or styles outside the dress code of the school is totally prohibited. Sporting long hair, for boys and hair hanging loose, for girls, goes against the norms of the school Boys must go for regular hair cuts and girls must have their hair neatly plaited Good grooming is part of good nurturing.

Parents Cooperation and Support:

The school authorities exhort all parents and guardians to lend full support and cooperation by checking that their wards attend classes regularly, are keeping up-to-date with their lessons, by attending regularly parents'- teachers' meetings as and when they are arranged and by regularly checking up with the teachers as regards their ward's progress.

Attendance and Promotions

Punctual and regular attendance is an important element for successful working and it is insisted upon. All absence from school will have to be followed up by all leave letter from the parents explaining and justifying the leave on the very next day the students turns up for class. A minimum of 80% attendance of the total working days of the school is MUST. A student who is short of attendance (below 80% will not be allowed to appear in Summative Examination.

Promotion is based on the day-today work of the students throughout the year and also on the performance and achievement in the scholastic and co-scholastic areas.
